AM Y BPCIC

Ffurfiwyd Band Pres Cenedlaethol Ieuencid Cymru, dan arweiniad ei gyfarwyddwr cerdd cyntaf a'r llywydd presennol, Edward Gregson, ym 1982 gan Ffederasiwn Cerddoriaeth Amatur Cymru, sy'n parhau i ddarparu cefnogaeth weinyddol a nawdd fel partner yng Nghelfyddydau Cenedlaethol Ieuencid Cymru. Yn ychwanegol at yr hyfforddiant sy'n cael ei gynnis drwy fandiau pres mewn cymunedau lleol ledled Cymru, mae'r Band yn cydnabod cefnogaeth gwasanaethau cerdd sirol yr awdurdodau addysg lleol, yn wir, daeth y syniad o ffurfio band pres cenedlaethol ar gyfer Ieuencid Cymru i fod, i raddau helaeth, o ganlyniad i frwdfrydedd tiwtoriaid y gwasanaethau cerdd.

Daw aelodau Band Pres Cenedlaethol Ieuencid Cymru o bob cwr o Gymru a byddant yn cael clyweliadau neu ailgylweliadau bob blwyddyn. Erbyn hyn, mae nifer fawr o'r cyn-aelodau yn enwog fel unawdwyr, arweinwyr neu fel perfformwyr gyda bandiau neu gerddorfeidd mwyaf blaenllaw Prydain. Bu'r rhan fwyaf o diwtoriaid BPCIC yn perfformio gyda Band Pres Cenedlaethol Ieuencid Cymru ar un adeg, ac mae'r un peth yn wir am bron pob un o staff Bugeiliol y Band.

Yn ychwanegol at Edward Gregson, bu gan y Band arweinwyr eraill megis Arthur Kenny, Bram Tovey, Howard Snell, James Gourlay, Frank Renton, James Watson, Nicholas Childs, Ray Farr a Nigel Boddice. Y cyfarwyddwr presennol yw Robert Childs, sydd (ynghyd â'i deulu) wedi bod â chyswllt cryf â'r Band ers ei ddyddiau cynnar.

Ers y cyngerdd agoriadol yn Neuadd y Brangwyn, Abertawe, daeth Band Pres Cenedlaethol Ieuencid Cymru yn enwog am berfformio gweithiau cyfoes. Comisiynodd y Band weithiau cerddorol gan nifer o gyfansoddwyr, ac yn eu plith Alun Hoddinott (Symffoni Rhif 8), Mervyn Burtch, Christopher Painter, John Phillips, John Pickard (Symffoni *Gaia*), Peter Graham, Nigel Clarke a Martin Ellerby. Ychwanegodd gweithiau comisiwn y Band yn sylweddol at y repertoire consierto i fandiau pres, ac mae hwnnw'n cynnwys consierts gan Mervyn Burtch (piano), Philip Wilby (ewffoniwm), Gareth Wood (trombôn, telyn), ac Alun Hoddinott (offer taro). Yn fwy diweddar, comisiynodd y Band *Concerto Grosso* i Fand Pres a Phedwar Unawdydd gan Alun Hoddinott, perfformiodd waith comisiwn newydd, sef Consierto i Gorn Tenor gan Gareth Wood, a'r Band roddodd y perfformiad cyntaf o'r Piano Consierto (4 llaw) o waith Bill Connor.

Ymhlith gweithgareddau'r Band hyd yma, mae teithiau i'r Iseldiroedd, Norwy a Chanada, perfformiadau ym mhrif Wyliau Cymru, gan gynnwys Proms Cymru, yn ogystal â darllediadau ar y radio a'r teledu.

ROBERT CHILDS (Cyfarwyddwr Cerdd)

Penodwyd Dr Robert Childs yn Gyfarwyddwr Cerdd Band Pres Cenedlaethol Ieuencid Cymru yn 2000. Mae ei waith fel cerddor profesiynol yn cwmpasu nifer o feysydd, yn ychwanegol at ei enwogrwydd byd-eang fel athro ac unawdydd ewffoniwm, a'i berfformiadau gyda nifer o fandiau mwyaf blaenllaw'r wlad. Ef yw Cyfarwyddwr yr adran Astudiaethau Band Pres yng Ngholeg Brenhinol Cerdd a Drama Cymru, Caerdydd. Mae Robert yn diwtor ac yn aelod o gyngor Bandiau Pres Cenedlaethol Ieuencid Prydain Fawr. At hyn, mae'n brofiadol fel cynhyrhydd recordiau ac ef yw sylfaenydd a Chyfarwyddwr *Doyen Recordings*.

Ym mis Mai 2000, derbyniodd Robert gyda balchder y gwahoddiad i ddod yn Gyfarwyddwr Cerdd y 'Buy As You View Cory Band', a thrwy hynny bu'n bosibl iddo ailafael yn ei gyswllt â Chymru yn ogystal â'r band y bu'n ei edmygu ers ei blentynod. Mewn byr amser, mae wedi llwyddo i adfywio bandio pres yng Nghymru drwy dywys ei fand newydd i safle'r 'ail orau' ym Mhencampwriaeth Ewrop a'u cynorthwyo i ennill Pencampwriaeth Agored Prydain ddwywaith (tlws na fu yn nwylo'r un band o Gymru ers 148 mlynedd) yn ogystal â'r Bencampwriaeth Genedlaethol. Dan ei arweiniad yn 2008, daeth band y Cory yn Bencampwyr Ewrop ac felly daethpwyd â'r teitl yn ôl i Gymru, a hynny am y tro cyntaf ers 28 mlynedd.

ABOUT THE NYBBW

The National Youth Brass Band of Wales, under its first musical director, and current president, Edward Gregson, was formed in 1982 by the Welsh Amateur Music Federation, which continues to provide administration and funding as a partner in National Youth Arts Wales. In addition to the training supplied through brass bands in local communities throughout Wales, the Band acknowledges the support of the local education authority county music services: indeed, it was in large part due to the enthusiasm of several music service tutors that the formation of a national youth band for Wales was suggested.

Members of the National Youth Brass Band of Wales are drawn from all parts of Wales, and auditioned or re-auditioned annually. A large number of former members are now well known as soloists, conductors, or as performers with top British bands or orchestras. The majority of NYBBW tutors once played in the National Youth Brass Band of Wales, as did nearly all of the Band's pastoral staff.

In addition to Edward Gregson, the Band's conductors have included Arthur Kenny, Bram Tovey, Howard Snell, James Gourlay, Frank Renton, James Watson, Nicholas Childs, Ray Farr and Nigel Boddice. It is currently directed by Robert Childs, who (with his family) has had a strong association with the Band since its early days.

From its first concert at the Brangwyn Hall, Swansea, the National Youth Brass Band of Wales has established an enviable reputation for performing contemporary works. Numerous composers have been commissioned by the Band, including Alun Hoddinott (8th Symphony), Mervyn Burtch, Christopher Painter, John Phillips, John Pickard (*Gaia* Symphony), Peter Graham, Nigel Clarke and Martin Ellerby. The Band's commissions have added considerably to the brass band concerto repertoire, and include concerti by Mervyn Burtch (piano), Philip Wilby (euphonium), Gareth Wood (trombone, harp), and Alun Hoddinott (percussion). More recently, the Band commissioned a *Concerto Grosso* for Brass and Four Soloists from Alun Hoddinott, featured a newly commissioned Tenor Horn concerto from Gareth Wood, and gave the first performance of the Piano Concerto (4 hands) by Bill Connor.

The Band also features a wide range of "test-pieces" in its programmes, ranging from the classics of the repertoire to the most recent. Added to this is the challenge of the latest large-scale transcriptions that few youth bands are able to tackle.

Tours to The Netherlands, Norway and Canada, performances at the major Welsh Festivals, including the Welsh Proms, together with radio and television broadcasts have all featured in the Band's activities to date.

ROBERT CHILDS (Music Director)

Dr Robert Childs was appointed Music Director of the National Youth Brass Band of Wales in 2000. His work as a professional musician encompasses many fields, in addition to his world-wide reputation as teacher and euphonium soloist, performing with many of the country's leading bands. He is Director of Brass Band Studies at the Royal Welsh College of Music & Drama in Cardiff. Robert is a tutor and council member to the National Youth Brass Bands of Great Britain. He is also an experienced record producer, founder and Director of Doyen Recordings.

Robert conducted and performed with the Yorkshire based Black Dyke Band for almost ten years; highlights of his tenure included performances with Lesley Garret, Philip Smith and The Beautiful South.

In May 2000 Robert was delighted to accept the invitation to become the Music Director of the 'Buy As You View Cory Band', thus re-uniting him with Wales and associating him with the band he has held in such high esteem since being a boy. In a short space of time he revitalised brass banding in Wales by steering his new band to become 'runners up' in the European Championships and to win both the British Open title twice (a trophy which had eluded Welsh bands for 148 years) and the National Championships. In 2008 he led the Cory Band to become European Champions, thus bringing back the title to Wales for the first time in 28 years.



CWRS PRESWYL

Bydd BPCIC yn cwrdd am ei gwrs preswyl blynyddol yn ystod gwyliau'r haf. Yn ystod yr wythnos bydd y chwaraewyr yn cael eu tiwtora'n arbenigol gan dîm o diwtoriaid profiadol sy'n dod o fandiau gorau'r DU.

Yn ogystal â cherddori, bydd aelodau'r band yn mwynhau rhaglen fywiog o adloniant fydd yn cael ei rhedeg gan y staff bugeiliol. Bydd y gweithgareddau fel arfer yn cynnwys chwaraeon megis nofio, pêl-droed a rownderi a digwyddiadau gyda'r nos megis cwis, nosweithiau talent a llawer mwy.

Daw'r wythnos i ben â pherfformiadau yn rhai o brif leoliadau cyngerdd Cymru. Yn fwyaf diweddar ymddangosodd y band yn Theatr Glan yr Afon yng Nghasnewydd, Galeri yng Nghaernarfon a Chanolfan Mileniwm Cymru yng Nghaerdydd.

RESIDENTIAL COURSE

The NYBBW meets for an annual residential course held during the summer vacation. During the week players are given expert tuition from a team of specialist tutors drawn from the ranks of the UK's best ensembles.

In addition to music making, Band members enjoy a lively entertainment programme run by the pastoral staff. Activities usually include sports such as swimming, football and rounders and evening events such as quizzes, talent nights and much more.

The week culminates with performances at some of Wales's top concert venues. In recent years the Band has appeared at the Riverfront Theatre in Newport, Galeri in Caernarfon and the Wales Millennium Centre in Cardiff .

REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates are accepted for audition on the approval of their county Head of Music Service (or his/her authorised representative or equivalent) and are expected to support music activity at school/college and county level. Where county activity does not exist, the Head of Department in school or college may initially support applications.
- Candidates should normally be of around Grade VIII standard though they do not need to have taken the exam.
- Candidates should be between 12 and 21 years old on 31st August 2008 (or 22 if still in full-time education).
- Players must be available for all course and concert dates. Please check your availability before applying.

THE AUDITION

During the short audition you will be asked to perform 2 contrasting pieces of your own choice (unaccompanied), a selection of scales and arpeggios and sight-reading. Those who are also offering a doubling instrument (eg. flugelhorn) will be asked to perform a short piece on this instrument.

Auditions will take place in November throughout Wales at the centres and dates given below. You should indicate on the enclosed application form which centre you would like to attend. We will contact you with details of your appointment in October.
