AM Y CCIC

Ffurfiwyd Côr Cenedlaethol Ieuenctid Cymru gan Ffederasiwn Cerddoriaeth Amatur Cymru, yn dilyn cwrs peilot a gynhaliwyd yng Ngwesty'r Bae, Aberystwyth ym mis Tachwedd 1984, i gefnogi traddodiad corawl hirsefydlog Cymru yn ogystal â'r datblygu sydd ei angen er mwyn i'r traddodiad hwnnw ffynnu. I'r diben hwnnw, bydd Côr Cenedlaethol Ieuenctid Cymru yn comisiynu darnau newydd yn rheolaidd, yn ychwanegol at archwilio repertoire corawl rhyngwladol sy'n ymestyn dros bron pum canrif.

Daw aelodau'r Côr, pob un ohonynt rhwng 16 a 21 oed, o bob rhan o Gymru, a byddant yn mynychu clyweliadau bob blwyddyn. Byddant yn cyfarfod am gyrsiau o bryd i'w gilydd, ond mae prif waith y Côr wedi ei ganoli ar wythnos o ymarfer dwys yn ystod yr haf, gyda chyfres o gyngherddau i ddilyn. Mae mwyafrif y tiwtoriaid a'r staff yn gyn-aelodau o'r Côr - roedd Llywydd y Côr, Bryn Terfel, yn un o'r aelodau cyntaf - a chaiff y cyfarwyddwyr cerdd eu penodi am gyfnod arferol o dair blynedd. Ymhlith y cyn-arweinwyr mae George Guest, Gregory Rose, John Hugh Thomas, Simon Halsey, Ralph Allwood, Jean Stanley Jones, David Rowland ac Islwyn Evans.

Mae Côr Cenedlaethol Ieuenctid Cymru wedi cynnal cyngherddau yn Llundain, Berlin, Leipzig, Bruges, Brwsel, Paris, Fienna, Budapest a Dilyn, yn ogystal â pherfformio ar draws Cymru, ac mewn nifer o brif eglwysi cadeiriol Lloegr. Bydd y darlledu'n rheolaidd ar y teledu a'r radio.

DAVID LAWRENCE (Cyfarwyddwr Cerdd)

David Lawrence yw un o arweinyddion ifanc mwyaf amryddawn y DU, ac mae wedi ennill enwogrwydd neilltuol am ei waith gyda chorau a chorwsau. Bydd yn gweithio'n rheolaidd gyda Chôr Radio'r Iseldiroedd a Chorws Symffoni Dinas Birmingham ac ef yw deiliad Record Byd Guinness am arwain y côr mwyaf yn y DU (6,846 o gantorion).

Mae ei waith wedi arwain David i Awstralia, India, Canada, De America yn ogystal ag Ewrop ac mae ganddo brofiad arbennig o arwain cerddoriaeth gyfoes. Ymhlith ei waith teledu mae 'The People's Chorus' a 'Songs of Praise' ac mae'n feirniad poblogaidd yn y gystadleuaeth 'BBC Choir of the Year'. Yn ystod haf eleni, bydd David yn arwain corau ieuenctid torfol gyda Cherddorfa Cwmni Opera Cenedlaethol Cymru, *Sinfonia Viva*, yr *English Symphony Orchestra*, yn ogystal â chyfarwyddo yng Ngŵyl Gerdd Ulverston a Bwrdeistref Newham yn y *Royal Festival Hall* cyn dychwelyd unwaith eto i Queensland, Awstralia i gynnal gweithdy a pherfformio fel arweinydd gwadd yno.

ABOUT THE NYCW

The National Youth Choir of Wales was formed by the Welsh Amateur Music Federation, as the result of a pilot course held in the Bay Hotel, Aberystwyth in November 1984, to support both the long-standing choral tradition of Wales and the development needed for that tradition to flourish. Toward this end, the National Youth Choir of Wales, in association with the Friends of the Choir, regularly commissions new music in addition to exploring an international choral repertoire that spans some five centuries.

Members of the Choir, who are aged between 16 and 21 years, are drawn from all parts of Wales, and auditioned annually. They meet for occasional day or weekend courses, but the Choir's main work is concentrated in a week of intensive rehearsals in the summer, followed by a series of concerts. The majority of tutors and staff are drawn from former members of the Choir - the Choir's President, Bryn Terfel, was himself a founder member - and musical directors are usually appointed for a three-year period. Former conductors include George Guest, Gregory Rose, John Hugh Thomas, Simon Halsey, Ralph Allwood, Jean Stanley Jones, David Rowland and Islwyn Evans.

The National Youth Choir of Wales has given concerts in London, Berlin, Leipzig, Bruges, Brussels, Paris, Vienna, Budapest and Dublin, in addition to performing throughout Wales, and at many of the major cathedrals in England. It broadcasts regularly on television and radio.

DAVID LAWRENCE (Music Director)

David Lawrence is one of the UK's most versatile young conductors, particularly known for his work with choirs and choruses. He works regularly with the Netherlands Radio Choir and the City of Birmingham Symphony Chorus, and holds the Guinness World Record for conducting the largest choir in the UK (6,846 singers.)

David's work has taken him to Australia, India, Canada, South America as well as Europe and has particular experience in conducting contemporary music. His television work has included 'The People's Chorus' and 'Songs of Praise' and he is a popular adjudicator for the BBC Choir of the Year competition.

This summer David directs massed choirs of young people with the Orchestra of Welsh National Opera, Sinfonia Viva, the English Symphony Orchestra, as well as for the Ulverston Music Festival and the Borough of Newham at the Royal Festival Hall before making a return workshop and guest conducting visit to Queensland, Australia.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

We are keen to ensure that no-one is deterred from applying for the National Youth Choir of Wales for financial reasons. All applications for assistance are treated in strictest confidence.

REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates are accepted for audition on the approval of their county Head of Music Service (or his/her authorised representative or equivalent) and are expected to support music activity at school/college and county level. Where county activity does not exist, the Head of Department in school or college may initially support applications.
- Candidates should normally be of around Grade VIII standard though they do not need to have taken the exam.
- Candidates should be between 12 and 21 years old on 31st August 2008 (or 22 if still in full-time education).
- Choristers must be available for all course and concert dates. Please check your availability before applying.

Auditions will take place in November throughout Wales at the centres and dates given below. You should indicate on the enclosed application form which centre you would like to attend. We will contact you with details of your appointment in October.

Auditions are free of charge but you are required to send a cheque, made payable to **WAMF (NYCW)**, for £15.00 as a deposit. The cheque will be returned to you if you attend your appointment at the agreed time. Those failing to appear for the auditions will forfeit the payment.
